To Whom it May Concern,

I am providing this as information regarding the proposal to install a communications tower at 222 Sandarac Dr. NW.

The Sandstone MacEwan Community Association (SMCA) remained neutral to the proposal and initially there was no feedback provided to the Association in opposition to the installation of a tower. Recently the Association has received several emails opposing the tower and large signs on lawns are now visible. It would appear there is a well-organized group of individuals who are opposed to the tower being placed in the middle of the Sandstone community and they are equally upset with the process thus far.

At our March 10, 2022, SMCA Board meeting several long-standing community members attended and they expressed feeling very frustrated with what they perceived to be a lack of consideration and dialogue on behalf of Rogers Communications. The Berkshire Citadel Church has received calls enquiring about the tower and there is a rumor folks are planning to get together on or near the property to oppose the tower.

If I am to understand the process to date, due to the pandemic, online presentations and distribution of information were made available through the City of Calgary. While all pandemic restrictions regarding community interactions have recently been removed by the City and Province, Rogers Communications has determined they will not now introduce any formal open house opportunities.

The SMCA Board has had several lengthy discussions and are of the opinion that Rogers Communications be encouraged to review their current process and reconsider facilitating an open house. As the President of the SMCA, I spoke with Councilor Jasmine Mian and requested her assistance to arrange a meeting with Rogers Communications.
